For over 100 years, the Rosso family has woven its legacy through the heart of Serralunga d'Alba, one of the best terroirs in Barolo and the world. Under the leadership of Davide Rosso, the winemaking philosophy here transcends tradition, embracing Davide's believe that "the wine must be the perfect copy of its terroir."



Roero Arneis DOC

Characterful and balanced, Arneis is one of the most respected and distinctive white wines of the Barolo region.

TASTING NOTE:

Vibrant and aromatic, this wine shows aromas of delicate white flowers mingling with citrus and a hint of almonds. Zesty acidity structures the palate leading to a layered and elegant finish.



'Donna Margherita' Barbera d'Alba DOC

Named after Davide's great aunt, this crisp and characterful red is the everyday wine of the Barolo region.

TASTING NOTE:

Bursting with juicy cherry and plum, underscored by vibrant acidity and soft tannins. An approachable, lively red with a refreshingly clean, smooth finish.



Langhe Nebbiolo DOC

This wine serves as an eloquent introduction to the complexity and elegance Piedmontese wines are celebrated for.

TASTING NOTE:

An unadorned, authentic expression of Nebbiolo: aromas of rose and cherry, with a hint of raspberry. Lively tannins and a bright acidity lead to a pure, elegant finish.



Barolo DOCG

The 'King of Wines and Wine of Kings' represents the pinnacle of Piedmont wines and is a narrative of the land it comes from.

TASTING NOTE:

A regal tapestry of cherry, rose petal, and earth. Firm tannins and vibrant acidity frame its elegance leading to a long, layered finish hinting at truffle and leather.
